
#### THE PROBLEM

In order to reduce energy usage while maintaining production rates, Tinker Air Force Base sought to replace its industrial lighting. Continued usage of outdated and inefficient lighting could compromise personnel safety, but any work would have to be conducted without any interruption to aircraft maintenance activities.

### THE SOLUTION

PowerSecure designed and implemented all services for Tinker Air Force Base. The full-scale lighting upgrade to LED was designed to meet the specific lighting, safety, and ROI needs of the facility, and these new fixtures were first installed in high-profile locations as retrofit solutions were conducted in non-essential locations. Furthermore, a wireless network control system was installed in the facility's mission-critical areas to ensure constant adaption to changing mission requirements. Easily customizable, the control system allows for granular regulation such as scheduling, zoning, and task tuning.
